# ICPAR commemorates Kwibuka 32 through community solidarity and support to survivors of the 1994 genocide against the Tutsi

On 15 May 2026, the Institute of Certified Public Accountants of Rwanda (ICPAR) is commemorating Kwibuka 32 in Ndera Sector, Gasabo District, as part of the national remembrance of the 1994 Genocide against the Tutsi.

The commemoration brings together ICPAR staff, members, students, survivors, and local leaders to honor the memory of the victims of the 1994 Genocide against the Tutsi, express solidarity with survivors, and reaffirm the collective commitment to unity, resilience, reconciliation, and the prevention of Genocide ideology.

In line with the Kwibuka 32 theme, "Remember, Unite, Renew," ICPAR is placing particular emphasis on renewal through community solidarity, remembrance, and support to survivors of the 1994 Genocide against the Tutsi. Through direct engagement and interaction with survivors in Ndera Sector, Gasabo District, the initiative is encouraging participants to reflect on the country's journey of healing and renewal while strengthening solidarity, resilience, and collective responsibility for preserving unity.

The commemoration is commencing with a visit to the CARAES Ndera Genocide Memorial, where participants are paying tribute to the victims of the 1994 Genocide against the Tutsi. The memorial serves as the final resting place for more than 30,000 victims, including former staff and patients of the hospital as well as members of the surrounding community. The visit is providing an opportunity to reflect on the importance of remembrance as a foundation for renewal and national unity.

Following the memorial visit, ICPAR is extending financial support to IGISUBIZO JEANETTE Association, an association of survivors of the 1994 Genocide against the Tutsi, as part of ongoing efforts to contribute to the survivors' economic wellbeing, empowerment, and continued renewal.

The Kwibuka 32 commemoration reflects ICPAR's continued solidarity with survivors of the 1994 Genocide against the Tutsi and support for national efforts that promote remembrance, unity, reconciliation, humanity, accountability, and social responsibility.
