

Register as CPA(R) Member

Eligibility To Become CPA(R) Member

In accordance with article 58 of ICPAR Law no. 11/2008, a person applying to become a member of the Institute of Certified Public Accountant, shall fulfill at least one of the following requirements:

1. Being a holder of a Certified Public Accountant (CPA) professional qualification issued by the Institute.

2. Being a holder of a professional qualification of a chartered accountant or certified public accountant issued by a body of professional accountants in another country which has full membership of IFAC.

Requirements For Registration

- 1. Copies of Degree(s) and Transcripts both notified
- 2. A copy of professional qualification Certificate (CPA, CA, ACCA, etc).
- 3. You must demonstrate at least 2 years of practical experience
- 4. Updated CV
- 5. A recommendation letter from a CPA-R or an employer
- 6. Attestation of not having been convicted by any court
- 7. A passport photo

8. Payment of building fees of Rwf.300,000 and Membership Application fees of Rwf.150,000
