Overview

Rwanda's business environment is rapidly evolving, driven by digital transformation, artificial intelligence, sustainability, changing regulatory requirements, geopolitical developments and regional economic integration under the African Continental Free Trade Area (AfCFTA). As the country advances the implementation of NST2 and Vision 2050, organisations are increasingly required to anticipate change, manage emerging risks and identify new opportunities for sustainable growth

At the same time, developments in financial reporting, including IFRS 18 and the IFRS Sustainability Disclosure Standards alongside growing expectations around governance, climate-related risks and responsible business practices, require senior executives to adopt more integrated, forward-looking

and strategic approaches to leadership and decision-making.

These developments require leaders to continuously understand emerging trends, challenge conventional approaches, share strategic experiences and strengthen their ability to make effective decisions in an increasingly complex and uncertain environment.

Through thought leadership, peer-to-peer learning, strategic dialogue and practical experience-sharing, the Forum will enable senior leaders to better understand emerging developments, assess their implications for their organizations' and identify practical strategies for navigating complexity, creating value and sustaining long-term organizational performance.





Goals and objectives

The Forum provides a platform for senior executives to engage on emerging business trends, exchange strategic experiences, explore innovation and strengthen executive leadership capabilities to drive effective decision-making, organisational resilience and sustainable growth.

- ▶ Strengthen collaboration between business leaders, regulators and policymakers in support of Rwanda's long-term economic transformation and sustainable growth.
